- Site is owned by Venkat Mannava
- Application Submittal/Review
 - Site Development Review Permit
 - Tentative Parcel Map
- Application requires Planning Commission approval



Project Location





Background

- General Plan: Medical Campus/Commercial
- Zoning: PD ORD. 03-19
 - Project is part of the larger Kaiser Commercial Project and is included as 'Phase 1B' (four parcels) under the Kaiser Dublin Medical Center Project Environmental Impact Report (EIR)
- Project site: 5.75-acres






Proposed Project

- Two four story hotels:
 - Tru by Hilton: 114 rooms/81,200 sq.ft., outdoor pool/courtyard and pickleball court
 - Element by Westin: 123 rooms/50,132 sq.ft.
- Restaurant/Retail Building:
 - 10,178 sq.ft. (opportunity for up to three retail tenants and one restaurant with outdoor seating)
- Construct other site improvements (i.e., parking, trash enclosures, landscape, etc.)
- Provide total of 310 on-site parking spaces




Proposed Project – Site Plan

Tentative Parcel Map

- Subdivide project site into three smaller parcels:
 - Parcel 1 (Element by Westin Hotel): 2.63 acres
 - Parcel 2 (Tru by Hilton Hotel): 1.96 acres
 - Parcel 3 (Restaurant/Retail Building): 1.16 acres





Environmental Review

- The project is covered under the Kaiser Dublin Medical Center Project EIR for which environmental impacts were analyzed
- Subject to the Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program and will need to mitigate for impacts related air quality, noise, transportation, etc.
